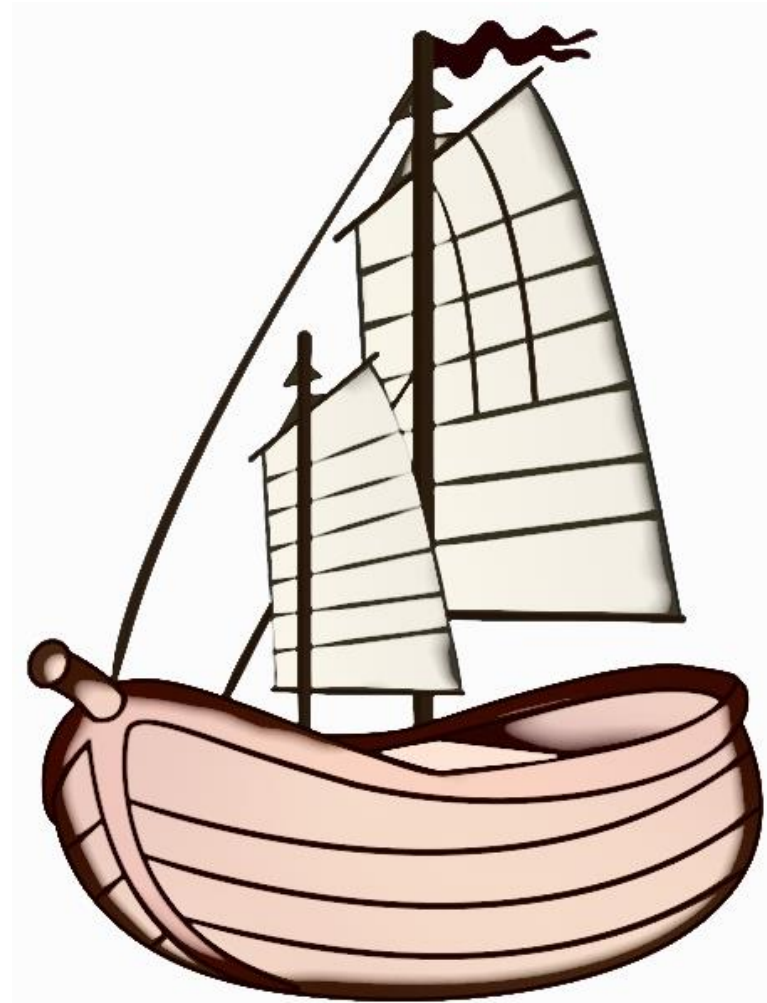
ACOLYTE TRAINING – There will be training Sunday, February 16 after worship for those children interested who have received their third grade Bible.
